For that purpose the Government has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development towards the cost of Sindh Education Reform Program (SERP), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the contract for Public Private Partnership in Education.

Promoting Private schooling in Rural Sindh is a scheme of the Sindh Education Foundation under the public private partnership component of the Sindh Education reform Program 2008-09.the project aims to provide support in establishing and managing of 1000 private schools in un deserve localities in 10 districts of Sindh which includes Larkana, Qambar-Shahdadkot, Dadu, Sanghar, Mithi, Khairpur, Shaheed Benazir Bhutto, Badin, Thatta & Umerkot.

For Assessment activity, the program intends to digitize the Student profiling records from 485 PPRS schools. Thus to increase the accuracy in data entry of student profiling, SEF is interested in hiring the services of a data entry firm that have expertise in large volume of data entry operations. For this particular purpose, SEF is keen to invite proposals from reputable organizations having proven relevant experience in data entry operations. This data will further be used by Education Management Information System (EMIS) application, a centralized database for all educational programs running under the umbrella of Sindh education Foundation.
