AGENDA:

To select reputable research firms to conduct standard verification survey of 4567 schools / applications in the history of Sindh Education Foundation in accordance with the PC-I of Integrated Education Learning Program.

PROCESS:

1- **Tender** Advertisement to conduct verifications survey was published on 7th February 2010 in national newspapers (JANG, DAWN, KAWISH, IBRAT) to pre-qualify the prospective research firms.

2- Following competent outsource experts of education sector were invited to conduct short-listing of research firms:

3- To evaluate the reputable & capable research firms from the pool of applicant firms, following short listing criteria for research firms were adopted:




